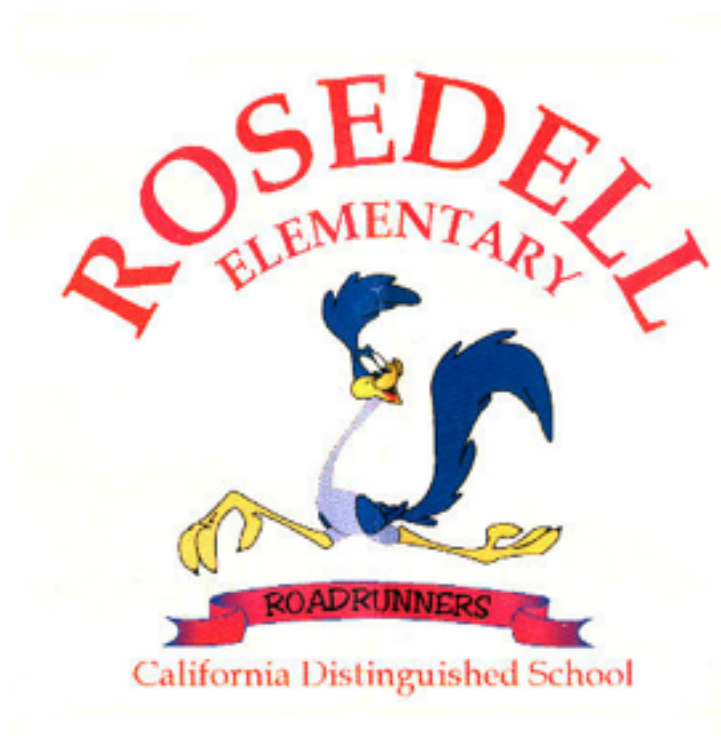

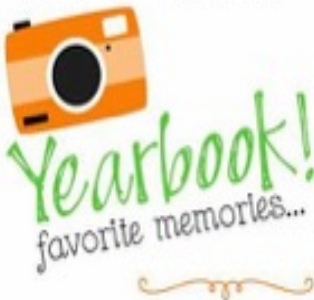

Book Fair.....

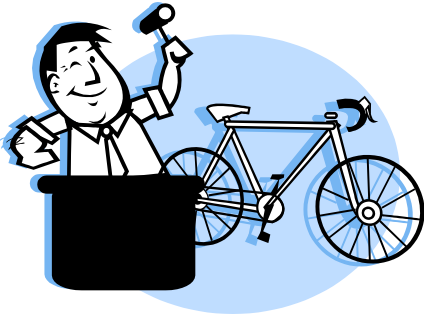


This year we will have two Book Fairs, one in the Fall and the other in the Spring.....

How are my fundraising dollars \$pent.....

• **Charleston Wrap:** Starts August 29th (Samples were on display at our Back to School Night and will be at our Welcome Back

Parent Tea) and is desperately needed to fund half the cost of the Performing Arts grade level workshops.

- **Popcornopolis** in September will go towards funding the 6th grade events.
- **Silent Auction/ Raffle** in October will fund events such as Red Ribbon Week, Mileage Club, Women in History, Health Week and more programs.
- **Cookie Dough:** in November with Mrs. Fields Cookie Dough and other baked goods will fund events such as Donuts with Dad's, Muffins for Moms, Father/Daughter and Mother/Son Activities.
- **Color Run** in March will fund half the cost of the Performing Arts Center workshop and Assemblies.
- **See's Easter Candy** in March Theatre Club will be selling Easter Candy and the funds will go towards the Theatre Club.
- **Community Rewards programs** run all year long (see below). They fund such programs as the earthquake bin, and much needed supplies.

Box Tops

There is an **EASY and FREE** way in which everyone can help to bring in money for Rosedell: **Box Tops for Education**, Clipping and turning in these labels is such an easy way to help Rosedell earn money for field trips, special events, computers for our students, and free educational items for our classrooms, office, and new playground equipment. Just by purchasing products cereal, granola bars, printer paper, school supplies, fruit snacks, and more, then clipping the specially marked labels and sending them in to school. **We earn CASH for Box Tops (10 cents each) toward FREE classroom, office, and playground supplies!**

This is the way you can help:

Clip — Clip the Box Tops from hundreds of participating products and send them to school. Each one is worth 10¢ when our school redeems them from Box Tops for Education.



With the free Shoparoo app, every grocery receipt earns money for our school. It works on smart phones and tablets and does not require any additional buying, selling, collecting, delivering, etc.,

1. Download the free Shoparoo app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
2. Once it's downloaded, select our school as your cause and take pictures of receipts!
3. Invite other parents and members of the community to participate.
